The Cedar Guesthouse

Surrounded by the red cliffs of the Baviaanskloof and with a beautiful view down the Cedar Valley, this exclusive farm house caters for the visitor who likes to nurture themselves in comfort and style. The century old house has been beautifully renovated with a slightly earthy touch to provide a tranquil and sheltered refuge amongst the rugged terrain of the kloof.

There is accommodation for 8 people sharing. Sleeping options include one double room with king size bed, three twin rooms with two single beds in each.

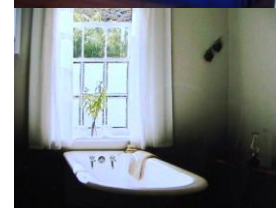
There are two bathrooms, both with baths and one with a shower, in addition to the private outside shower. A spacious lounge, a well-equipped kitchen, and a beautiful wraparound veranda make you feel comfortable and at home. Close to the house is a braai/barbeque area set in a landscaped indigenous garden – a stunning setting for star-filled nights around the fire.

You can find relief on hot days in a small plunge pool fed by clear, fresh water from the mountain stream.

For those wanting to leave the worries of preparing food behind, then Marta's Restaurant is only 50 meters away. Prior booking for the meals is required.

Just-for-two Cottage

This romantic getaway is situated where two valleys meet, embraced by deep red cliffs and touched by morning sunlight. The cottage was built in the late 1800s, and was the welcome “refuge” for Italian prisoners of war in the early 1940s. Its delicious charm lies in its simplicity – a bedroom, kitchen and bathroom built of stone and clay.

The Just-for-Two has been delicately renovated with the utmost respect for the beauty of the simple life and the warmth and history of the original earthy building materials. The cottage is fully equipped with gas appliances and cooking equipment, with a braai area outside. There is no power, with paraffin lamps for night light. The bath and shower are open to the sky, providing an unforgettable experience under the stars. The flush toilet is strategically placed apart to give you a beautiful view up the kloof.

The cottage is also located within three quarters of an hour’s walk from magnificent bushmen paintings, and a ten minute walk from the Labyrinth.

This remains our favourite place for romantic getaways, with wide open spaces, red cliffs, endless beauty and a warm and cosy nest at the end of the day.

For those staying in the Just-for-two, and wanting food prepared, Marta’s Restaurant is only 500 meters away. Prior booking for the meals is required.

Cob Cottage

Cob Cottage lies in the valley against the cliffs on the far side of the valley and is tucked away and very private. It has a queen sized bed and very comfortable lounge. The open plan kitchen is fully equipped with gas appliances for self catering guests. There is a delightful bathroom, half open to the sky, so you can lie in the bath and watch the eagles and stars overhead. There is solar power in the cottage for lights or you can use the paraffin lamps provided.

This beautifully crafted cob cottage is part of an empowerment project hosted by the Another Way trust.

A decade ago when tourism started growing in the area, Willem and Marta had a dream to run their own guesthouse.

We built the cottage during our annual Cob Building Workshop in 2008 and had 13 people contribute love, sweat, tears and blessings. The cottage is built of mud, adobe bricks, straw bales and poplar beams from the farm, and is a true indication of what can be achieved with local materials.

Cecelia Fraser was the Green architect from Cape Town that donated her time and energy into designing the cottage. Jake Levi, a 14 year old that loves the farm and is a wizard behind a camera and computer put together a funding video with Willem and Marta.

And so the dream unfolded. We got funding from guests that have become regulars on the farm and we were able to furnish this beautiful cottage.

We are very proud of this achievement and wish Marta and Willem every success in their project.

Camping Chalets

The three camping chalets are nestled against the poplar trees just below the main farmhouse and restaurant area. These sweet cob buildings are a rondavel-type room with 2 beds in each and a lovely view down the fields. Single mattresses are provided, and guests need to bring their own bedding

Each camping chalets has an attached bathroom open to the sky with flush toilet and a shower with solar geysers.

A communal boma area is available that features a little open kitchenette and braai area for those staying in the camping chalets. We provide a gas stove for cooking, sink with cold water for washing up and wood for the fire. Please note you are to bring your own utensils
